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## Course of Study

A course of study is required for all classes outside of ACE.
The course of study should include the student's name and grade, the length of the class (hours) the goals for the class, how it will be taught, the curriculum used, and how they are given the grade.

Most elective classes for High School require 90 hours of instruction or participation for a semester's credit.
