
7th Grade Social Studies State History Project

This is the State History Project put out by ACE Ministries. It replaces The Social Studies PACES # 79 -84. This project is designed to take a full semester to complete. Please submit a copy of the final project with your grade packet. (You may e mail a pdf of the completed project, or send it on a disk if you do not want to print out all of the writing.)

According to the ACE directions, this project should result in a 15 page typed (20 page hand written) report. This sounds daunting, especially to those who are not fond of writing. Remember, that it does not all have to be written at one time. You may structure your writing as a series of 1 – 4 page reports on each of the outline headings. Keep all of the pages in your state notebook. At the end of the semester, you may turn in the separate reports, or take the time to teach your student how to take the individual reports and create transitions between them to tie them into one long research project. This is a valuable technique to learn. Please grade your student's work according to the grading sheet provided at the end of this packet. Do have them complete all of the activities listed under "Requirements for Independent Study."

Make good use of your public library and explore state history landmarks in your area! This can be a fun, enlightening and exciting adventure. We hope that you and your student enjoy this opportunity to explore your state history!

Note: *If you completed a State History Project in 4th grade*, please follow this outline to create a Nation Report for a country of your choice. Include stories or biographies of any missionaries or church leaders that may have worked in that country. Instead of the locating and labeling the US map, use a world map to highlight the country, its capitol, geological landmarks, and any other places of significance.
